Shooting Suspect Arrested

The suspect in yesterday's shooting on Dransfeldt Road was arrested early this morning. Parker Police Detectives identified a 43-year-old Erie, CO male as the suspect in yesterday's shooting. He was arrested at his home in Erie at 2:00 a.m., July 14, without incident.

Officers responded to a report of an individual shot shortly after 2:00 p.m. Tuesday, July 13, in the 10300 block of Dransfeldt Road. The victim was transported to an area hospital with non-life-threatening injuries.

Parker Police Department Detectives are preparing the case and will recommend the below charges to the 18th Judicial District Attorney's Office:

Attempted 1st Degree Murder-Class One Felony
Criminal Attempt to Commit Class One Felony-Class Two Felony
2nd Degree Assault-Class Four Felony
Menacing-Class Five Felony
Criminal Attempt to Commit a Class Four Felony-Class Five Felony
Illegal Discharge of Firearm-Class Five Felony
Prohibited Use of Weapons-Class Two Misdemeanor
Reckless Endangerment-Class Three Misdemeanor

We appreciate the collaboration of the Douglas County Sheriff's Office Impact Unit and the Erie Police Department, who arrested the suspect.

A charge, whether recommended or ultimately filed, is merely an accusation and a defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.
